### Resources

**Monuments**: Some people have asked us who to contact for monument improvements. While we are unable to endorse any one in particular, we know that Braham Monument lifted and added borders around some flat stones last summer and the owners were very pleased. They can be reached at 320-396-2938.

**Plant Stakes & Stands:** There are times when plant stakes and stands are removed because of corrosion and safety issues. Most garden centers carry this type of product but we know that Green Barn Garden Center in Isanti off of Hwy. 65 is great place to find replacements. 763-444-5725 is their number.

**Removing Lichen from Stone:** This comes from the International Southern Cemetery Gravestones Association. If there appears <u>lichen growth</u> on the headstone in the form of grey and orange patches, then moisten the affected area and scrub it with a mixture of one part of ammonia and four parts of water. Finally, wash it with regular water. Do not use household cleaners and only use soft-bristle brushes.
